



NEWS and INFORMATION

The Region F Regional Water Planning Group is seeking nominations to fill fifteen (15) positions on the Region F Regional Water Planning Group. Nominations will be received for two representatives for Public, two representatives for Counties, two representatives for Agriculture, two representatives for Water Districts, one representative for each category: Municipalities, Industries, Environmental, Electric Generating Utility, River Authority and Water Utility.

- (2) <u>Public</u> These positions are for persons having no economic interest in any of the interest categories that comprise the Regional Water Planning Group, other than as a normal customer.
- (2) Counties These positions are for county governments for the 254 counties in Texas.
- (2) <u>Municipalities</u> This position is for governments of cities created or organized under the general, homerule, or special law of the state. The Region F Planning Group has defined this position as a person who will represent municipalities with a population of 10-50,000 and a person who will represent municipalities with a population of less than 10,000.
- (1) Industries This position is for a corporation, partnerships, sole proprietorships or other legal entities that are formed for the purpose of making a profit and which produce or manufacture goods or services and which are not Small Business (small business is defined as corporation, partnership, sole proprietor, etc. that are formed for purpose of making a profit; independently owned and operated; have fewer than 100 employees; with gross annual receipts of less than \$1 million).
- (2) Agriculture These positions are for persons or entities associated with production or processing of plant or animal products. The Region F Planning Group has defined one position as a person who will represent irrigated farming and one position as a person who will represent ranching.
- (1) Environmental This position is for persons or groups advocating the conservation of the state's natural resources, including but not limited to soil, water, air and living resources.
- (1) Electric Generating Utility This position is for persons, corporations, cooperative corporations, or any combination thereof, meeting each of the following criteria: own or operate for compensation equipment or facilities which produce or generate electricity; produce or generate electricity for either wholesale or retail sale to others; and are neither a municipal corporation nor a river authority.
- (1) River Authority This position is for any district or authority created by the legislature which contain areas within their boundaries of one or more counties and which are governed by boards of directors appointed or designated in whole or part by the governor or board.

(2) Water District – These positions are for water districts or authorities, created under the authority of either Texas Constitution, Article III, § 52(b)(1) and (2), or Article XVI, §59. The Region F Planning Group has defined one position as a person who will represent regional water suppliers and one position as a person who will represent irrigation districts.

(1) Water Utilities – This position is for any persons, corporations, cooperative corporations, or any combination thereof that provide water supplies for compensation except for municipalities, river authorities, or water districts.

In consideration of nominees and the selection of new voting members, the Regional Water Planning Group shall strive to select the most qualified person to represent the interest group for which nominated and to achieve geographic, ethnic and gender diversity.
