

## **Agenda Item 6a. Review and consider adoption of Major Water Providers**

This agenda item is to discuss and select a list of Major Water Providers (MWP) for the Region F 2026 Plan. The TWDB defines a MWP as “*a subset of water user groups (WUGs) and/or wholesale water providers (WWP) identified by the Regional Water Planning Group (RWPG) to be particular significance to the region’s water supply.*” The RWPG may select any subset of entities that it determines to be significant as MWPs.

If an entity is not selected as a MWP, they will still be planned for and included in the 2026 plan. Entities that are not a MWP will also still be eligible for state funding.

For the 2021 Region F Water Plan, the RWPG identified the following entities as Major Water Providers:

- Colorado River Municipal Water District
- Brown County Water Improvement District No. 1
- City of Odessa
- City of Midland
- City of San Angelo

It is proposed to retain the same list of Major Water Providers for the 2026 Plan. All provide significant volumes (>10,000 acre-feet of water) to the region and will continue to do so over the planning horizon.
